CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR VARSITY FOOTBALL TEAM:
As they captured the HHSAA Division 2 title by defeating Kapa'a High School by the score of 21-14. Siale Hafoka broke the scoreless tie in the 2nd quarter by returning a block punt by Kupono Kahae-Ampong for a touchdown followed by catching a 39-yard pass from Etuati Storer that put the ball on the 5-yard line. That set up Kiliona Keohuloo's double reverse for another touchdown. Bailey Honda capped the Luna's scoring by returning a 55-yard interception touchdown in the 3rd quarter. Siale Hafoka was named the OC16 Impact player of the game.

Our school's previous best post-season finish was in the 1997 Neighbor Island Football Championship against Waimea of the Kauai Interscholastic Federation. The Lunas went undefeated in the Maui Interscholastic League's 10-game regular season and finished with 12 wins.
