Seniors should be signing up for your FAFSA (financial aid) appointments. These appointments are scheduled every Wednesday. There is also a list of documents that you must also bring to your appointment, see Miss Kristy for the list of documents and to sign up for an appointment.

**Seniors applying for financial aid** must apply for a Federal Student Aid ID at least a week before your appointment. Students must create an ID for themselves and ONE parent, and bring both ID's with them to their FAFSA appointment.
