Tickets can be purchased beginning Monday, February 29 in Ms. Abad's room (P8) during Lunch and after school. Only CASH will be accepted. The deadline to purchase tickets will be Tuesday, March 15, 2016. Payments and permission forms must be submitted at the same time and will only be accepted if all detention hours and withholds are cleared for each student. Everyone in your party (who you would like to sit with) must submit payment at the same time to have preferred seating. For example - 10 students want to sit together on same table, those 10 students must provide payment and forms together. When submitting your payment and permission forms, please be sure to indicate the name of your date (or who you are taking, especially if non-LHS student or non-Junior) on the top right hand of your permission form. This helps us to ensure that you and your date will be seated at the same table. You must be originally seated at the same table as the person you are taking."
