FAFSA: Seniors should be signing up for your FAFSA (financial aid) appointments. These appointments are scheduled every Wednesday. There is also a list of documents that you must also bring to your appointment, see Miss Kristy for the list of documents and to sign up for an appointment.

Seniors applying for financial aid must apply for a Federal Student Aid ID at least a week before your appointment. Students must create an ID for themselves and ONE parent, and bring both ID's with them to their FAFSA appointment
