Lahainaluna High School promotes this service as a way to maintain a pleasant and safe environment for more than 1,100 people who are on campus daily. **How it works:** If you see something suspicious or know that someone broke the law, you can text a tip to our campus safety response team. These include Fighting, bullying, theft, harassment, vapes/e-cigs, drugs, alcohol, insubordination (student is a danger to them self or others), suicide.

When texting a tip, include the following information: Location of incident, What is happening, and the Description of student/teacher (clothing, backpack, hat, etc.). **You will receive a response from a member of the response team:** You are not required to give your name, it's 100% Confidential and answer any question you are asked regarding the situation as best as you can **Help us keep our campus safe and secure!** Just a reminder that **False tips are a Crime!**

CAR WASH TICKETS INCENTIVE - If students are willing to sell more than the one requested ticket received in Po'okela, there is an incentive for selling more tickets.
