**For payment and permission forms to be accepted, students must** bring a signed permission form and contract, bring a SCHOOL ID (no other form will be accepted), bring cash payment, have less than 15 hours of detention and have cleared all withhold obligations (if you recently paid for a withhold, please bring receipt as proof in case spreadsheet is not updated)

**Payment will only be accepted at lunch in P8. Doors will close promptly 5 minutes before the end of lunch.**
