Field Day information on Wednesday, March 7th:

There will be no Po'okela class that day and a special bell schedule will be in place.

-Students should expect to get wet as there are several activities involving water. They may have a change of clothes for that day, but please remember that students are to be in uniform before and after the activity.

-During last week's Po'okela class, you should have been told which team your Po'okela is on and whose Po'okela class your Po'okela class are combined with.

-There are a total of 5 teams per grade level and each station will have one team for each grade level competing at any given moment. (eg: a freshman class will always be playing with/against a sophomore, junior, and senior team.) The rotation was also made so that you should never be playing the same team twice.

-Backpacks are to be left in their class before recess (period 2) so that bags and personal items do not go missing while participating on the field.

-After morning recess, all students, teachers, and staff members should report immediately to the football field and to their first event.

-Reminders, announcements, and instructions will be given from the press box the entire duration of the activity as needed.

-Depending on time, teams will have approx. 7 minutes at each station. Teachers are asked to help the volunteer teachers in charge at each activity so that there is enough time to actually play.

For payment and permission forms to be accepted, students must :

- bring a signed permission form and contract
- bring a SCHOOL ID (no other form will be accepted)
- bring cash payment
- have less than 15 hours of detention
- have cleared all withhold obligations (if you recently paid for a withhold, please bring receipt as proof in case spreadsheet is not updated)

Payment will only be accepted at lunch in P8. Doors will close promptly 5 minutes before the end of lunch.

If you are still in line when the doors close, you must return the following day. No exceptions. To avoid having to return or miss out on an opportunity to register, pay early and arrive early. On the final day - same guidelines will apply. If your payment is not received before the doors close promptly 5 minutes before the end

of the lunch period, you have missed the deadline and will not be able to attend. These guidelines will be strictly followed given the chaos of last minute payments last year. *Again, pay early and arrive early.*
