ID/Uniform:

Are you currently a sophomore or junior? Do you have a *cumulative* GPA of 3.7 or higher? If the answer to BOTH of these questions is YES, you are eligible to apply for membership to the Lahainaluna Chapter of the National Honor Society. You will need to bring your report card (the one dated February 9, 2018) to Ms. Olson in P-18 to verify your cumulative GPA and to pick up an application. The deadline to return your application to Ms. Olson will be 1pm on THURSDAY, March 29, 2018. There will be no extensions or exceptions to this deadline.

For payment and permission forms to be accepted, students must :

- bring a signed permission form and contract
- bring a SCHOOL ID (no other form will be accepted)
- bring cash payment
- have less than 15 hours of detention
- have cleared all withhold obligations (if you recently paid for a withhold, please bring receipt as proof in case spreadsheet is not updated)

Payment will only be accepted at lunch in P8. Doors will close promptly 5 minutes before the end of lunch.

If you are still in line when the doors close, you must return the following day. No exceptions. To avoid having to return or miss out on an opportunity to register, pay early and arrive early. On the final day - same guidelines will apply. If your payment is not received before the doors close promptly 5 minutes before the end of the lunch period, you have missed the deadline and will not be able to attend. These guidelines will be strictly followed given the chaos of last minute payments last year. *Again, pay early and arrive early.*
