In support of its local community and athletes, [The Westin Kā'anapali Ocean Resort Villas](#) will be hosting an autograph signing opportunity with Lahainaluna High School alumni and NFL draft prospect, Hercules Mata'āfa. Hercules was born and raised on Maui in a family of seven kids. He and three of his siblings have gone on to play sports at the collegiate or professional level both nationally and internationally. Hercules grew up playing football and wrestling from a young age and competed through high school in both sports. Hercules said, "As far back as I can remember football was always one of my passions. My mom always says that my first word wasn't mama or dada it was football," he continued "I get my strength from my Polynesian background and smarts from my mother." During his time at Lahainaluna High School, Hercules recalls many fond memories, he said, "I loved the feeling of winning big games with all the teammates that I grew up and played with since we were kids playing Pop Warner."

When it came time for college, Hercules knew he was serious about his football career and decided to play for the Washington State Cougars. He had a great career with the Cougars, where he earned Polynesian Football Hall of Fame College Player of the Year

in 2017. Hercules said, "Running out into a stadium with thousands of people cheering you on, is an atmosphere and feeling I will never forget." In December of 2017, Hercules decided to forego his senior year at Washington State and declare for the draft. With his dreams of the NFL in sight, Hercules said his goals for the NFL are "...to have a healthy and successful career and be a role model to other athletes from the islands." With the draft quickly approaching, April 26th through April 28th, Hercules says he will be happy no matter what happens.
