If you are looking for ways to engage your students, C-SPAN's StudentCam is an ideal opportunity to challenge middle and high school students to think critically about issues that affect their communities and are of national importance. This competition among students is a great addition to the classroom, whether incorporated into your curriculum, recommended as an independent project or offered as extra credit.

This year, C-SPAN is asking students to create a **5-6-minute video documentary** on the theme: **"WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE AMERICAN? Choose a constitutional right, national characteristic, or historic event and explain how it defines the American experience."** Students are asked to evaluate how this right, characteristic or event is

upheld in our society or challenged by current events. Rights or characteristics may include aspects of democracy, opportunity, liberty, justice, equality, diversity, unity, individualism, other rights, guiding principles or shared values.

Completed videos must be submitted to [www.studentcam.org](http://www.studentcam.org) by Jan. 20, 2019.

The C-SPAN Education Foundation awards 150 student and 53 teacher prizes, totaling \$100,000 in cash. All student winners will receive cash prizes ranging from \$250-\$5,000, and teachers who are listed as faculty advisors will have a chance to win cash prizes of up to \$750.
