Congratulations to our football team as they captured their 4th consecutive HHSAA Division 2 title by defeating Kapa'a High School by the score of 21-10 this past Friday at Aloha Stadium. In the win, Josh Tihada rushed for an all-division single-game state-record 310 yards and 3 touchdowns. In all, Josh rushed for 1,087 yards and 18 touchdowns on 176 carries in state tournament play. His 19 total state touchdowns are seven more than anyone else. Earlier in the week, Tuipulotu Lai won the KHON 2 Cover 2 Lineman of the year award! The defense held in check a potent Kapa'a offense to 10 points and Tre Rickard intercepted a pass late in the game to seal the win.
