In softball, our girls softball team defeated Baldwin HS by the score of 14-11. The win gives our girls a 2 game lead with 3 games to go. The winning pitcher was [Seraya Casco](#). Leading hitters were Ocean Makekau who went 4-5 and drove in 5 runs, Daisha Dagdag 2-4 with a double, Nohili Hong 2-5 with 2 doubles, [Keani Pagan](#) 2-5 with a double, [Seraya Casco](#) 2-3, and Tamia Duldulao-Kahaialii with a double! The key to game was Taylor Ganer's 2-run homer at the 7th inning to give the Lady Lunas a 9-4 lead! Awesome victory!

In water polo, our girls water polo team defeated King Kekaulike HS by the score of 5-1 for their 3rd straight win. Dakota Delos Reyes scored all 5 goals for the win! Awesome performance!

In boy's golf, our boys golf team defeated Baldwin by the low score of 201-205. Matt Ramelb shot a 41, followed by Jonas Marcial's 51, [Kaito Nishiji](#)'s 54 and Josh Gutierrez's 55 to conclude their team season 5-7. Next up is individual competition.
