Membership in the National Honor Society is open to Juniors and Seniors. To be eligible for membership, each member must carry a minimum of a 3.7 cumulative grade point average. After first-semester report cards come out, sophomores and juniors who meet this initial criterion will be invited to submit an application detailing their academic awards and honors, community service activities and the leadership positions held, both in and out of school. The Lahainaluna Staff is asked to evaluate the students that they know based on leadership, character and community service. Finally, the six-member NHS Faculty Council (the faculty advisor is the sixth, non-voting member) reviews students' applications and teacher input, to determine which candidates will be offered membership.

In recent years, several students have received letters in the mail from scammers offering membership to various 'honor societies'. The scammers ask for a membership fee plus money to purchase special cords or stoles or other "recognition wear". Again, this is a **scam**, and students will not be allowed to wear these items during LHS commencement ceremonies. There is only ONE Lahainaluna Chapter of the National Honor Society. The current advisor is Ms. Olson. Any communication about NHS will come through the school because it is expensive to send letters home. NHS dues are \$10 per year and the ONLY people who pay dues have been inducted into NHS and the ONLY people who collect them are the treasurer or the advisor.
