Lahainaluna High School will be offering the PSAT exam on Thursday, January 16, 2020 at 7:50am. The PSAT (or Preliminary SAT) measures; verbal reasoning, critical reading, math problem solving, and writing skills developed over many years, both in and out of school. It is designed to show how well a student will do on the SAT exam; which is the most common college entrance exam.

The cost will be \$15.00. Students must return their signed registration form and payment, to Miss Kristy in the College & Career Center by the new extended date, Tuesday, January 14, 2020. Money Orders can be made payable to Lahainaluna High School. No checks will be accepted. NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON AFTER TUESDAY, JANUARY 14, 2020. The test will last approximately 3 hours. Testing will take place at Lahainaluna High School library.
