COUNSELORS CORNER:

Lahainaluna High School will be offering the PSAT exam on Thursday, January 16, 2020 at 7:50am. The PSAT (or Preliminary SAT) measures; verbal reasoning, critical reading, math problem solving, and writing skills developed over many years, both in and out of school. It is designed to show how well a student will do on the SAT exam; which is the most common college entrance exam.

The cost will be \$15.00. Students must return their signed registration form and payment, to Miss Kristy in the College & Career Center by Friday, January 10, 2020. Money Orders can be made payable to Lahainaluna High School. No checks will be accepted. **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON AFTER FRIDAY, JANUARY 10, 2020.** The test will last approximately 3 hours.
