The prompt is "What healthy habit have you developed in Hawai'i during COVID-19?" 2-D and multimedia art pieces will be accepted. Keiki ages 5-18, with parent permission, are encouraged to submit 2-D and multimedia art pieces. Entries will be accepted from November 4 to December 4, 2020 and each contestant can submit up to five entries.

Students are invited to enter this educational video contest sponsored by the state Department of Transportation, Highways Division, Maui District. The project is designed to promote public awareness of why storm water matters to the islands' environment and encourage good community practices to help keep our storm water clean.
