Lahainaluna is ready to register 9th grade students for the PSAT 9 exam scheduled for Thursday, January 21 at 7:50 AM in our Kamakau Library. The PSAT is a practice SAT exam, any students planning on attending college in the future should take these practice exams to help prepare themselves for the real SAT.

The test is about 3 hours long and they will be missing class to take the exam. Lahainaluna only has **20 seats available** for this test due to social distancing guidelines.

Freshmen students must submit the registration form that is on the website and a \$20 fee to the Lahainaluna main office. Payment must be made in cash, money order or cashier's check for the exact amount, payable to Lahainaluna High School. NO personal checks will be accepted.
