2. Here are the DEADLINES: **12/1:** \$20 late fee for any orders on or past this date
3/1: \$40 late fee for any orders on or past this date
4/11: NO orders accepted past this date
3. Diploma cover is included in price and will be delivered in bulk to the school.
4. You can order other things online, including class rings. But it's important that it's done through the Lahainaluna page. All extra items will be sent to you directly. *Only the caps and gowns and diploma covers will come to the school.* Hope your period 3 is going well!!! This will be Ms. Ellis' last reminder until we approach the second deadline.

Payment must be made in cash, money order or cashier's check for the exact amount, payable to Lahainaluna High School. NO personal checks will be accepted. Deadline to register is Friday, January 15 at 2 PM!!! **BUT** don't wait, all seats could be taken by the end of November.
