The 2021 STARTALK Hawai'i Chinese Teacher Institute, through the University of Hawai'i, is seeking 12 students (US residents or legal permanent residents only) to learn Chinese language (Mandarin) and contemporary culture.

All tuition and fees are covered by the STARTALK grant, which is funded by the U.S. National Security Agency. The program runs June 28-July 9 and classes are taught from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (Hawaii Standard time), synchronously via Zoom, followed by additional tasks and challenges to be completed asynchronously. The application deadline is April 20, 2021, and late or incomplete submissions will not be considered.
