Lahainaluna AP Students. Everyone should login to their MyAP account on College Board now and complete the digital practice test. Why?

1. The steps to access the practice test will be the exact same steps you will use to access your test on the day of your exam.
2. The practice test will show you exactly what the exam will look like on exam day.
3. If your computer needs to be updated or you receive an error message. We can help you troubleshoot the problem. If the problem cannot be fixed we can issue you a school chromebook.

We are trying to ensure that everyone will be able to access their digital AP exams now, **no one will be able to help you on exam day.** Please let Miss Kristy know if you have any questions or concerns.

The final I-Ready testing window is here! While the COVID-19 situation remains the same, students will be taking the test at home. Students can log in to the testing portal from 7am to 9pm Monday to Friday. The URL is [clever.com/in/hawaii](https://www.clever.com/in/hawaii). The username is your 10 digit student ID number and your password is your date of birth in the following format: MMDDYYYY. Once you are logged on, click on the I-Ready icon. Complete both Math and Reading Diagnostic Test. Here is a successful testing tip: Pace yourself, read each question, and answer carefully.
