Lahainaluna AP Students. Everyone should login to their MyAP account on College Board now and complete the digital practice test. Why?

1. The steps to access the practice test will be the exact same steps you will use to access your test on the day of your exam.
2. The practice test will show you exactly what the exam will look like on exam day.

3. If your computer needs to be updated or you receive an error message. We can help you troubleshoot the problem. If the problem cannot be fixed we can issue you a school chromebook.
