English (choose one of the following): a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA upon graduation in English Language Arts courses A score of at least 3.0 on the SBA ELA test or AP English Language exam, a score of 480 on the SAT English exam or 18 on the ACT exam also qualify.

Then you must demonstrate proficiency in a second language-You can take the Avant Assessment for free in early March, right here on campus. (And if you need to retake it, the cost is about \$20.)
