Hey Class of 2025 Graduating Seniors! Do you speak, read, write, and understand two languages? You may be eligible for the Hawaii State DOE Seal of Biliteracy! Who is eligible, you ask? Graduating seniors who can demonstrate proficiency in 'Ōlelo Hawai'i or English:

Ōlelo Hawai'i: a minimum of 3.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) upon graduation in Hawaiian Language Arts courses

English (choose one of the following): a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA upon graduation in English Language Arts courses A score of at least 3.0 on the SBA ELA test or AP English

Language exam, a score of 480 on the SAT English exam or 18 on the ACT exam also qualify.

Then you must demonstrate proficiency in a second language- You can take the Avant Assessment for free in early March, right here on campus. (And if you need to retake it, the cost is about \$20.)
