More than 150 high school and college students from across Maui participated in a fast-paced schedule of activities, with on-site visits to the Fairmont Kea Lani, Four Seasons Resort Maui, Wailea Beach Resort, Hotel Wailea, CoralTree Hospitality, Residence Inn Maui Wailea, and AC Hotel by Marriott Maui Wailea. LEI is a workforce development initiative to inspire Hawai'i youth to select careers in the Hawai'i hospitality industry by providing them with the necessary means to achieve success.
