from grade 11, a 480 on the Reading/Writing SAT exam, or a 4.5 overall score on the most recent WIDA exam). Then, you must demonstrate proficiency in a second language: Lahainaluna offers the Avant Language exam at no cost (although there is a fee for re-takes) in March.
