You must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA across four years of 'ōlelo Hawai'i ELA or 'ōlelo Hawai'i (English has other options, like a 3.0 on the ELA SBA from grade 11, a 480 on the Reading/Writing SAT exam, or a 4.5 overall score on the most recent WIDA exam).

Then, you must demonstrate proficiency in a second language: Lahainaluna offers the Avant Language exam at no cost (although there is a fee for re-takes) in March.
